Golf Cart Rules of Operation

All persons wishing to operate a golf cart on the city streets must ensure compliance with the following requirements:

- 1. Proof of current liability insurance.
- 2. Must have vehicle inspected by the West Frankfort Police Department
- 3. Must comply with the published "Rules Concerning Alternate Transportation for the City of West Frankfort" as periodically updated.
- 4. Must purchase a permit (\$35.00) and display a City Decal on rear of vehicle. Permit expires every calendar year.
- 5. Must have current & valid Illinois driver's license.
- 6. Must obey all traffic laws of the State of Illinois and the City of West Frankfort
- 7. Must be 21 years of age.
- 8. Must be operated only on city streets, except where prohibited.
- 9. May **NOT** be operated on U.S. Highways 37 or 149 except to cross highway at any intersection.
- 10. Must **NOT** be operated in excess of posted speed limit.
- 11. Any person operating or in actual physical control of a golf cart on a roadway while under the influence is subject to Section 11-500 through 11-502 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes (625 ILCS 5/11-500 11-502).
- 12. Golf Carts may NOT be operated on sidewalks or in the City Park other than parking areas.
- 13. Golf Carts may **NOT** be operated on streets, highways, and roads under the jurisdiction of the Illinois Department of Transportation. (i.e.: US State Highway 37 and US State Highway 149).
- 14. A physically handicapped applicant must submit a certificate signed by a physician certifying that the applicant is able to safely operate a qualified golf cart.
- 15. The City may **suspend or revoke** a permit upon finding that the holder has violated any provision of this ordinance, or there is evidence that the permit holder cannot safely operate a qualified golf card on the roadways.

VIOLATIONS

- 1. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of \$75.00.
- 2. Any second or subsequent offense shall result in the revocation of the permit for three (3) to five (5) years.
- 3. If any violation of this ordinance also constitutes a violation of a criminal statute of the State of Illinois, the violator shall also be subjected to criminal prosecution.
- 4. Golf Carts are subject to impound under City Ordinance LW-27.
